Play Park Upgrade


Board in March to discuss the various phases of the project, how it originated, and some of the challenges we have faced along the way. The phases include replacing the goalposts, the installation of the MUGA, renovating the seating area with sensory panels and the installation of a trampoline. Future phases will include replacing more of the play park equipment (some not fit for purpose), introducing some new equipment and a " Circuit" around the perimeter of the Recreation Ground (Ballantrae Primary were keen for this phase). Exercise equipment was requested and discussed for adults, with the possibility of placing these strategically around the circuit.

Our priority for the next few months is to ensure that the MUGA, seating area and trampoline elements of the project are progressed and for these to be in place for use by the community this year, 2019.

Funding is now in place for the MUGA and by the time you read this, construction work is expected to have started towards the end of April. Several grant applications have been submitted for the remaining funds required to purchase the ground trampoline which the sub group hopes to have installed immediately after the MUGA installation has been completed. A funding application has been submitted to Ayrshire Leader towards the redevelopment of the seating area to make it accessible to all ages and abilities. Chris advised a decision is expected towards the end of April.
