
Ballantrae News

At the first meeting of the new season current President Jessie Brown said she was delighted to receive it on behalf of Ballantrae - and showed members a picture of Miss (Nellie) Mitchell, the third president of Ballantrae WRI in 1951 with a cake to celebrate the branch's 21st birthday.
